Paku Paku Fortune Teller

Supplies Needed:

- Paper
- Markers or pens to decorate

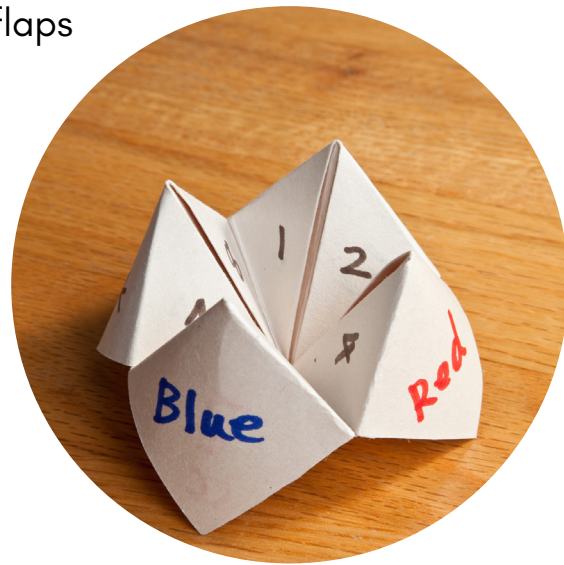
Instructions:

Step 1: Use the next page to fold a sheet of paper into a Paku Paku fortune teller

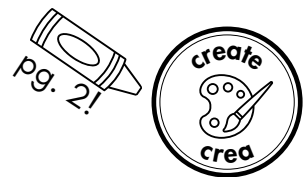
Step 2: Write your fortunes inside and decorate as desired

Step 3: Decide how your fortune teller will work...

- Write colors or numbers on the flaps
- **Example:**
 - Pick a number at random between 1-8... open and close the teller that number of times and then unfold the flap to reveal your fortune!

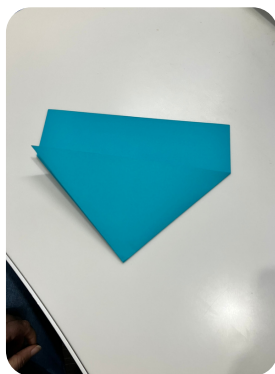
Paku Paku Fortune Teller



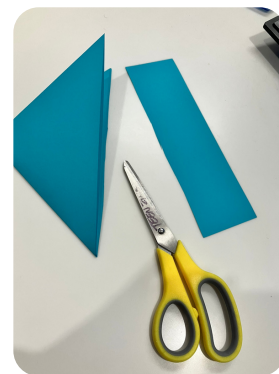
1. Grab some paper



2. Fold one corner to make a right triangle



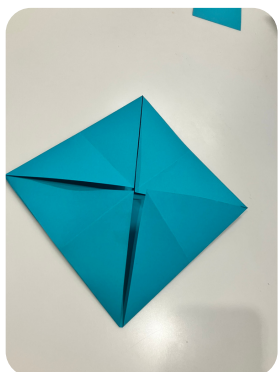
3. Fold second corner down making a triangle



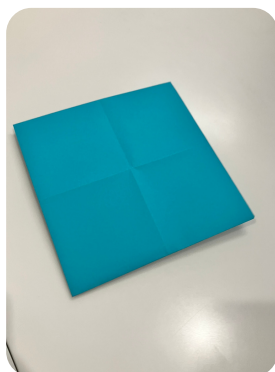
4. Cut off the flap - you now have a square of paper



5. Open up the square and fold the point of one corner into the center



6. Repeat with each of the corners



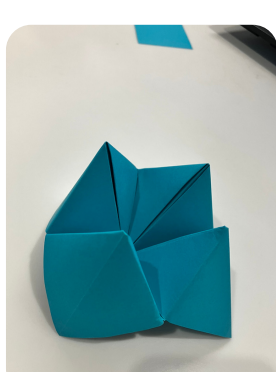
7. Flip it over



8. Repeat - fold a corner to the center point



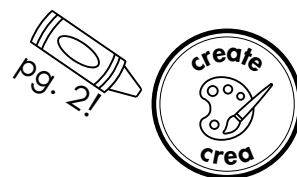
9. Fold all the corners to meet the center point



10. Flip it over and slide your fingers inside to make the fortune teller!



11. Open each flap to write the fortunes on the inside



How to make slime

Follow the instructions below. When you are done, check off your completed "Create" badge on Page 2!

Supplies Needed:

- 1/2 cup of clear or white school glue
- 1 tblsp. of contact solution
- 1/2 cup of water
- 1/2 tsp. of baking soda
- Food coloring, glitter, or anything you want to mix in your slime
- Bowl and spoon

Instructions:

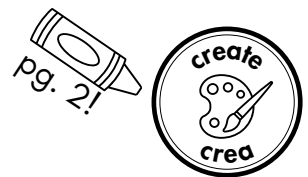
Step 1: In a bowl, mix together the water and glue

Step 2: Add your mix-ins such as food coloring or glitter

Step 3: Mix in baking soda a little at a time to make your slime firm

Step 4: Mix in the contact solution

Step 5: Stir your slime vigorously until the slime comes together!



Mario Kart Glider

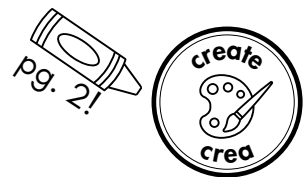
- Paper

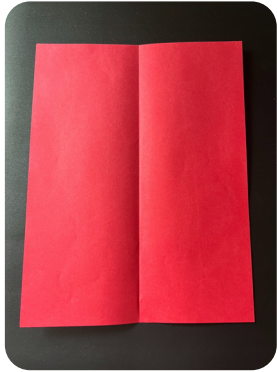
Step 1: Use the next page to fold a piece of paper into a glider

Step 2: Decorate your glider however you want! We have some Mario Kart glider designs to help inspire you

Step 3: Time to race your gliders!



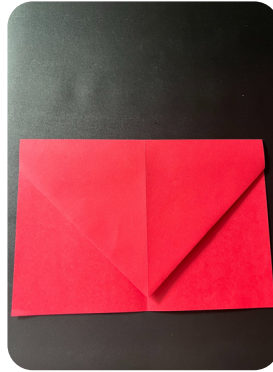
Mario Kart Glider



1. Fold the paper in half



2. Unfold and then fold on the top corners to the center line



3. Fold the top peak down to the edge of the previous fold, leaving 2.3" at the top



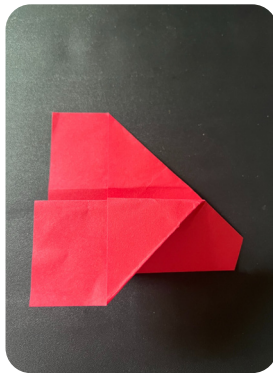
4. Fold the upper sides to the center line



5. Fold the top about 1/2 inch



6. Fold the plane in half



7. Fold both flaps to create the wings
